How It Works

Step 1

Become a member of the Best Practices Repository Community by completing the registration form and activate your account. Complete your detailed profile to highlight your areas of interest, areas of expertise, and location.

Step 2

Once your profile is set up, share publications, research, guides, and best practices documents so that other Collaborators can find and access the information you choose to share.

Step 3

Use your newly created account to access the NLWIC Best Practices Repository Community Forum to connect with other users, participate in discussions, and exchange valuable insights and resources.
